WRITTEN AUTHORIZATION TO PREPARE AND TRANSMIT ELECTRONIC EXPORT INFORMATION (EEI)  
ROUTED EXPORT TRANSACTION - RESPONSIBILITIES OF PARTIES

USPPI Responsibilities:

In a routed export transaction where the foreign principal party in interest authorizes a US. Forwarding or other agent to prepare and file the EEI, the USPP must maintain documentation to support the information provided to the forwarding or other agent for preparing the EEI and provide such forwarding or other agent with the following information to assist in preparing the EEI:

- i. Name and address of the US. Principal party in interest;
- ii. US. Principal party in interests, IRS, EIN;
- iii. Point of origin (State or FTZ);
- iv. iv, Schedule B description of commodities;
- v. V. Domestic (D), foreign (F), or FMS (M) code;
- vi. Schedule B. Number;
- vii. Quantity/unit of measure;
- viii. Value
- ix. Upon written request from the foreign principal party in interest, the Export Control Classification
- x. Number (ECCN) or sufficient technical information to determine the ECCN; and
- xi. Any information that it knows will affect the determination of license authority.

Note to above paragraph: For items in (ix) and (), where the foreign principal party in interest has assumed responsibility for determining and obtaining license authority, the USPPI must, upon request, provide the FPP and its Authorized Agent with the correct ECCN. In addition, the USPP must provide the FPPI or the Authorized Agent any information that it knows will affect the determination of license authority. EMO Trans will not be held responsible for determining ECCN and License Authority.

Authorized Agent Responsibilities:

In a routed export transaction, the Authorized Agent is responsible for; obtaining this written authorization from the foreign principal party in interest to prepare and file the EEI on its behalf; preparing, and filing the EEI based on information obtained from the USPPI, FPPI, and/or other parties involved in the transaction; maintaining documentation to support the information reported on the EEI, and upon request by the USPP, provide appropriate documentation to the USPP verifying that the information provided by the USPP was accurately reported on the EEI. The forwarding or other agent must provide the following information:

- iii. Ultimate consignee Obtained from USPPI/FPPI — dependent upon agreement in writing between USPPI & FPPI)
- iv. Intermediate consignee; Obtained from USPPI/FPPI — dependent upon agreement in writing between USPPI & FPPI)
- v. Forwarding or other agent name and address; vi. Country of ultimate destination; Obtained from USPPI/FPPI — dependent upon agreement in writing between USPPI & FPPI)
- vi. Loading pier
- vii. Method of transportation
- viii. Exporting carrier
- ix. Port of export
- x. Port of unloading
- xi. Containerized
- xii. Weight –
- xiii. ECCN (Obtained from USPPI/FPPI — dependent upon agreement in writing between USPPI & FPPI)
- xiv. License Authority (Obtained from USPPI/FPPI - dependent upon agreement in writing between USPPI & FPPI);
